Who should study for PMP?

PMP is designed for project management personnel in a variety of industries. IT, Accounting and Finance, Construction, Human Resources, or in any area that requires you to manage projects – the Scope, Time, Cost, Quality, Resources, Communication, Risk, and Procurement – PMP is the right qualification for you.

Educational and professional experience requirements

To be eligible for the PMP credential, you must meet certain educational and professional experience requirements. All project management experience must have been accrued within the last eight consecutive years prior to your application submission. The requirements for experience and education are as follows:

Educational Background	Project Management Experience	Project Management Education
High school diploma, associate's degree or global equivalent	Minimum five years/60 months unique non-overlapping professional project management experience during which at least 7,500 hours were spent leading and directing project tasks*	35 contact hours of formal education
OR		
Bachelor's degree or global equivalent	Minimum three years/36 months unique non-overlapping professional project management experience during which at least 4,500 hours were spent leading and directing project tasks*	35 contact hours of formal education

**Leading and directing project tasks as identified in the Project Management Professional Examination Specification. Within the total hours of project management experience, experience in all five process groups is required. However, on a single project, you do not need to have experience in all five process groups.*

Project Management Professional Review

Our PMP Professional Review course was designed to get students successfully through their 4 hours computer based examination.

- 5 day course (7 hours of classroom instruction, per day, by an experienced PMP certified instructor)
- Participants who successfully complete the course receive a certificate verifying 35 contact hours of project management training completed. (5 days X 7 hours of training per day = 35 hours of training).
